The NAACP's One Million Jobs Campaign is here to help you secure your next job. Finding employment can be difficult for anyone, but research shows that

it can be twice as hard for those with a criminal record. The One Million Jobs Campaign guides participants through the job application processes at partner employers — including

Yale New Haven Hospital, Hartford Healthcare, FedEx, and more — that are committed to giving OMJC participants fair consideration in the job application process.



The OMJC Training Program is a weeklong job-readiness workshop designed to prepare participants for successful job applications at our partner employers. Subjects covered include:

- Interview skills and techniques
- Resume development
- Technology skills readiness
- How to discuss a criminal record during the job application process

During the weeklong program, facilitators guide participants through the entire job application process, from beginning to end. Participants create their resumes, perform mock interviews, learn to advocate for themselves, and finally apply for positions of interest at OMJC partner employers.

The training program occurs in nightly two-hour sessions from 5:30-7:30, Monday through Friday, for one week.
